Medication Terms

Any health concerns must be discussed with your vet before your pets stay with us and we must be updated on any changes.

- All medication must be in the original packaging from your vet so we know exactly what the medication is.
- · You must provide a syringe with oral meds.
- Please make sure there is enough medication to last until your pet goes home.
- If a medication (such as oral antibiotics) needs to be kept in a fridge Please let us know.
- Medications may be given once a day (every 24 hours), twice a day (every 12 hours), three times a
 day (every 8 hours), or more often.
- We do charge for administering medication such as cream, drops or given by syringe.
- This is 50p per administration, per medicine if it is given once or twice a day (from breakfast time to bedtime).
- If your pet needs to be given medication 3 times a day (every 8 hours) then we charge £8 for the dose that is given after 11pm up to 6am.

CONTROLLED DRUGS

Sometimes, pets are prescribed drugs are controlled by the Medicines Act 1968.

These include opioid based pain medications, seizure medications (pentobarbitone), anti-anxiety medications (alprazolam, diazepam).

Unfortunately, we are not insured to store or to give controlled drugs.
